*Washington, DC (October 5, 2020)* – Capital Harvest on the Plaza (CHoP) will host a mini pop-up market this Thursday, October 8 from 11am – 2pm on Woodrow Wilson Plaza at the Ronald Reagan Building and International Trade Center. The market located at 13<sup>th</sup> & Pennsylvania Avenue in Northwest D.C. has remained closed this season and is excited to be returning to the downtown community.

Swizzler Food Truck, Sugar Plug Bakery, DelMarVa Kettle Korn and Larry's Produce will be participating in the first of its kind mini pop-up market.

Earlier this year, the District of Columbia granted CHoP permission to utilize the curb at 13<sup>th</sup> & Pennsylvania NW for curbside pick-up. Fans of the market are encouraged to place orders in advance with their favorite vendor for curbside pickup. Members of the CHoP staff will be on-hand to guide shoppers. Seating will also be available for onsite dining.
